Position Title:

Dump Truck Driver

Job Description:

Drives truck equipped with dump body to transport and dump loose materials, such as ABC, gravel, crushed rock, or asphalt. Driver is required to verify the type of material they are hauling as well as the weight of the material. Individual must follow a schedule for pick-ups and deliveries of material. Use of hand and foot controls to dislodge and loosen dump material adhering to body of truck. Driver pulls levers or turns crank in truck repeatedly to tilt truck body and dump contents. Driver is required to deliver their materials according to the job specifications and timetables allotted and keep their truck clean and in good working order.

Position Duties & Responsibilities

- Candidate should be able to drive a tandem, tri, quad or a quint axle dump truck
- Maintain compliance with Federal and State Department of Transportation regulations
- Manage proper receipt and delivery of quarry tickets to proper individuals by completing all paperwork in a timely manner.
- Perform pre-trip, en-route and post trip inspections of vehicle by ensuring truck is always clean and in safe operating conditions (i.e., Check tires, oil and fluids regularly so that the company can ensure all trucks are working properly for your safety
- Be able to work weekend, holidays, and some nights if needed
- Must be able to climb in and out of truck repeatedly throughout the day.
- Must be able to communicate and interact with other workers and providers in a professional and courteous manner
- Must be able to follow instructions when necessary
- Must be able to clean out truck if debris is stuck in the bed. This requires climbing into the bed of the truck and removing the debris
- Must be able to sit in a vehicle for several hours at a time without impeding their driving
- Must know how to manage their time well and make independent decisions
- Must be able to drive a stick shift
- Perform all other duties as assigned by management



Qualifications:

- All applicants must be authorized to work in the United States. Pre-employment checks to include: drug testing, skills testing, and motor vehicle records review
- Applicant must have *at least* a Class B commercial license with *at least* two (2) years dump truck driving experience and a clean driving record
- Have a high school diploma or equivalent
- Applicants must have a good understanding of math and angles to properly position the truck bed to dump materials in measured amounts.
- Applicant regular and peripheral vision abilities should be sharp enabling them to be aware of other trucks and heavy equipment that may frequently surround them at job sites.

Working Conditions:

Environment may be full of dust or particles from dumping of materials. Local travel to and from construction, quarry and renovation sites. Work day generally begins early and may stretch into early evening or night depending on job deadlines.

Physical Requirements:

Applicant must be in good physical, mental, and emotional health that will not endanger or interfere with their day-to-day activities or those of other workers or providers.
